FOREWORD

Following the decision of the NSA (Wales and Border Region) Ram Sale Committee not to proceed with either the early or main ram sale at Builth Wells, McCartneys decided to hold this sale at Brecon. It has given several noted breeders the opportunity to present their rams for sale and we can certainly recommend them as worthy of your further inspection. All purchasers must notify us if they are going to attend the sale and the normal social distancing rules will apply.

Vendors are allowed in to the sale but we respectfully request that only one representative of the vendor be present in the sale pen and in the sale ring at time of sale.

GENERAL INFORMATION

LOCATION - The sale will be held at Brecon Livestock Market which is a modern purpose built facility and which is located at Warren Road, Brecon, Powys LD3 8EX.

MOVEMENT LICENCES - All vendors must hand in a completed General Movement Licence. The market holding number is 52-63-8010. Intending purchasers should have their CPH number ready to complete the correct movement licence before departure from the market.

CONDITIONS UNDER COVID-19

- 1) We ask all purchasers to contact the office and register in advance of the sale.
- 2) Please remember that purchaser spaces will be limited so we ask for one person/purchasing farm to attend.
Please enter the sale ring only when you want to purchase sheep.
Please leave the sale ring and pay for your purchases as soon as you have bought your Rams.
Social distancing must be maintained at ALL times.
Disposable gloves will be available in the market for your use.
Please follow instructions from market staff.
- 3) The sale ring should only be entered from the main doors into the foyer, where everyone should register and put on gloves.
- 4) The ring has been marked out using 2 metre spacing's, with seats where applicable. It is essential that every individual maintains social distancing at all times to avoid any physical contact.

- 5) When the sale has concluded please go to the window of the market office to settle your account and collect paperwork. If a queue develops 2 metre spacing's are again being used throughout the corridor to maintain social distancing.
- 6) We ask that every person who attends the sale conducts themselves in a responsible manner in order to protect the health of their families and the families of other individuals at the market. We must all conduct our business in a manner which helps the NHS.
- 7) There will be no official inspection of stock this year. So we ask purchasers to check all animals carefully before purchase. Any problems must be reported to the auctioneers before leaving the market.
- 8) If you are unable or do not wish to attend the market but would like to bid on animal/s then the auctioneers will faithfully execute purchase for buyers. Please contact them and put your instructions in writing 48 hours in advance of the sale. Alternatively you can arrange to make a telephone bid during the sale.
- 9) The sale will be livestreamed.
For further information please contact the auctioneers.
- 10) Only those that are buying and selling should attend – **onlookers and the public should not attend.**

Any person over the age of 70 should not attend sales.

Any person that is knowingly ill, showing symptoms of the virus or has an underlying health issue should not attend sales.

Children should not attend sale.

Any lady that is knowingly pregnant should not attend sales.

TERMS OF BUSINESS

We do politely remind all purchasers of our terms of business. All accounts should be settled on the day of sale and we do expect any potential purchasers who are not known to the auctioneer to provide references before purchasing any stock at Brecon. In addition, any agents who attend the sale to buy on behalf of a third party should inform the auctioneer, prior to the sale commencing, of who they intend to buy for and also provide details of when the accounts will be settled. In addition, agents will be liable for any stock purchased for a third party and the account until it is settled.

The Cattle Identification Regulations 2007

The above Order came into operation on 6th April 2007 and your attention is drawn to **Regulation 4, Schedule 1, Article 3 (3)**. Regulation 4 requires the owner of a bovine animal kept on any premises to mark or identify that animal in an approved manner, within 36 hours for a bovine animal born in a dairy herd and within 20 days for any other herd. Please ensure that your cattle are marked with an approved Ear Mark.

Conditions of Sale

All stock is sold under the Conditions of Sale as recommended for use by the Livestock Auctioneers' Association for England & Wales together with McCartneys Special Conditions as posted in the Market. When these special Conditions are at variance with the Livestock Auctioneers' Association Conditions then McCartneys' Conditions shall prevail. The auctioneers reserve the right to refuse injured or unfit livestock for sale. All stock remaining on the premises after the sale does so at the purchaser's risk and responsibility.

Trading Terms

New buyers or buyers who have not bought at recent sales must have supplied bankers references before bidding.
